ROGERS, AMBASSADOR OF CANADA IN PERU, HAS BEEN DESIGNATED SPECIAL AMBASSADOR FOR THE INAUGURATION OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC, HIS EXCELLENCY GENERAL HECTOR BIENVENIDO TRUJILLO MOLINA. THE CEREMONIES WILL TAKE PLACE IN CIUDAD TRUJILLO ON AUGUST 16, 1957.
