A Message was received from the Senate informing this House that the Senate had passed the following Bill, to which the concurrence of this House was desired:—

Bill No. 363 (Letter G-12 of the Senate), intituled: "An Act for the relief of Ann Martha Treglown Goodfellow".

And also,—A Message communicating to this House the evidence taken before the Standing Committee of the Senate on Divorce to whom was referred the petition on which the above mentioned Bill was founded, praying for a Bill of Divorce; together with the papers produced in evidence before them, with a request that the same be returned to the Senate.

The House resolved itself again into Committee of Supply.
