The Farm Finance and Taxation Research Institute has recently been established by a group of farmers and professional agrologists concerned about equity in the tax system and the lack of decision making information on farm finance and taxation.

The Farm Finance and Taxation Research Institute is a non-profit agricultural finance and taxation research organization, with primary focus on farmers and farm matters. Policies and affairs are controlled by a Board of Directors elected annually by the members. The Institute is open to people with an interest in farming and agribusiness.

The purpose of the Institute is to carry out research and analysis on problems in farm finance and taxation.

The objectives of the Institute are:

- conduct research on the effect of finance and taxation policy and law on the viability of the agriculture sector,
- conduct research on the effect of proposed amendments to finance and taxation policy and law on the viability of the agriculture sector,
- 3. to consult with the federal and provincial governments to assist in the development and amendment of policy and law to maximize the viability of the agriculture sector with respect to farm financing and taxation,
- to consult with other farm organizations to co-ordinate activities relating to finance and taxation policy and law,
