The following answers, deposited with the Clerk of the house, are printed in the official report of debates pursuant to standing order 39:

C.M.H. SOLICITORS, ONTARIO

Question No. 50—Mr. Houck:

What were the names of the special solicitors retained by Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation and what fee was paid to each of them in the year 1958 in the counties of (a) Lincoln; (b) Welland; (c) Haldimand; (d) Halton; (e) Wentworth?

Answer by: **Hon. Howard C. Green (Minister of Public Works):**

The names of solicitors who were retained by Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation or who were paid fees in respect of work allocated by the corporation in the year 1958 are outlined below. Because there is normally considerable time lapse between retainer and payment, fees paid will include work for which the solicitor was retained prior to 1958 in some cases. Similarly fees paid do not cover work for which the solicitor was retained in 1958 but for which he has not yet submitted his account. Amounts paid in each instance include both fees and disbursements.
