Bill reported.

Mr. Mazankowski (for the Minister of Justice) moved that the Bill be concurred in.

Motion agreed to.

Mr. Deputy Speaker: When shall the Bill be read the third time? By leave, now?

Some Hon. Members: Agreed.

Mr. Mazankowski (for the Minister of Justice) moved that the Bill be read the third time and passed.

Hon. Bob Kaplan (York Centre): Mr. Speaker, I want to speak on this Bill as I did on the preceding one and to refer those who want to follow the debate on Bill C-108 to the earlier Bill and the reasons for not developing our arguments and position on the Bill and to ask that the Bill be adopted.

Commercial Arbitration

Motion agreed to and Bill read the third time and passed.
