

Speaker gives a casting vote, and any reasons stated by him are entered in the Journal.

11. No member is entitled to vote upon any question in which he has a direct pecuniary interest, and the vote of any member so interested will be disallowed. Personal interest.

12. (1) Mr. Speaker shall preserve order and decorum, and shall decide questions of order, subject to an appeal to the House without debate. In explaining a point of order or practice, he shall state the standing order or authority applicable to the case. Decorum in the House.

(2) When Mr. Speaker is putting a question, no member shall enter, walk out of or across the House, or make any noise or disturbance.

(3) When a member is speaking, no member shall pass between him and the Chair, nor interrupt him, except to raise a point of order.
