Dear Sir Arthur.

In submitting the accompanying documents and Bank Draft for your signature I am doing so satisfied - after careful review of correspondence and Minutes of Alba. Prov. Hors. meeting submitted to me that all is in order and in keeping with the expressed wishes of that Executive body.

There apparently was never any question of, or expressed desire for, complete local autonomy of administration in L.P.F. matters north and south of a given line in the province, the only question was the division of the financial allotment made to the province through us, and which is a matter the General By-Laws of the Corporation in Art. 26 make quite clear to the Provincial Headquarters.

The necessary returns having been made by Alberta to date, therefore permits me to submit these to you Sir, for signature and completion. I attach a copy of my letter to Mr Wakelyn, for advice.
