All subscription lists received before the 31st March in each year, will appear in the next forthcoming report, while those received after that date shall be omitted."

"If reservations and special donations are not mentioned at the time when the contributions are sent in from the Local Committees, the whole amount will be considered as devoted to the general interests of the Society."

The attention of the Local Committees is particularly requested to the above regulations.

"All applications for aid from this Society are proposed at one meeting of the Society and considered at the next."

"The Executive Committee are authorized to grant, at their discretion, a sum of money not exceeding £40, towards an outfit for any newly ordained Clergyman of the Church who may require such assistance, previous to his assumption of actual duty in the Province."

"No person shall be qualified to vote at any general meeting of the Society, nor to be elected a member of the Executive Committee, who has not been a Subscriber for three months preceding the day of meeting."
