Frederickton Gleaner—The horses of the racing stable being campaigned by Trainer William Sharon arrived here last night from St. John and are now at their quarters at the Frederickton Park Association.

That these horses will not be at the Campbellton meeting this week is due entirely to the manner in which the horsemen were fooled by the manage- ment of the St. John track.

The Sharon stable was shipped to St. John on representation that there would be \$500 purses and that certain classes would be offered, but when they arrived there they found \$200 purses, except for the free-for-all, and other classes than those promised.

The result was that most of the horses were not started at St. John and lost the week. Then when it came time to ship to Campbellton it meant an expense of more than would make it a profitable trip so the horses came here.

No announcement has as yet been made as to whether the classes for the "Fredrick meeting next week have been or not—J. D. B.
