Chas. L. Pitts, a Halifax Soldier

This brave young soldier was a native of Halifax, a son of the late D. H. Pitts, who was connected with H. M. Dockyard in this city several years ago His mother was Florence Reddin of Charlottetown, a niece of Judge Reddin of that city, whither the family removed after the father's death. A few years ago they took up their residence in Toronto, where his mother and his two brothers, William and Jack, reside.

Charles Levis Pitts was about twenty three years old and was a great favorite with all who knew him. Another officer writing to his mother, told her that her brave son, had volunteerel to go with the rescue party and was the only one of the forty who was killed by the shell. The officer added: "It is an honor to have worked with him; he had endeared himself to the hearts of all the corps," A friend of the gallant young soldier, writing to The Morning Chronicle says that "volunteering to go on the rescue party was what anyone knowing Charlie Pitts would have expected. He never thought of himself, and made great sacrifices to get to the front," James H. Reddin, barrister, and E. J. Reddin, of Charlottetown, are uncles of the deceased.


