THE NEW LEAGUE.

The new league is to be fashioned on the idea of a reorganized Khalifate, and the president of the league would be a titular Khalif. At present there is considerable discussion going on as to who would be the Khalif, some wanting King Fuad of Egypt, while others object on the grounds that Egypt is not an independent country. The central idea of the scheme is that the Khalifate should be a representative institution and not a personal office and should function through a personal assembly of accredited delegates representing the entire Moslem world.

The result would probably be the creation of a permanent representative Khalifate council at Mecca, which while giving cohesion to the Islamic states would confront the western power with a solid block and would witally change the whole situation in the near east.


