"I am Transport accountant, H.Q., M.D.No.13. On 31st May, 1940, I issued Travelling Warrant #5362 covering return transport Calgary to Edmonton for exort party - Cpl. Mcrsh, private Batty, Warrant escort party - Cpl. Mcrsh, Private Batty, Warrant for M-16788 pte. Elkowich, G. Edmonton Regiment, also covered transportation from Edmonton Regiment, for M-16788 pte. Elkowich, G. Edmonton Regiment, and one other prisoner, the total value of the Warrant being \$19.50. Travelling Claim covering expenses being \$19.50. amounting to \$4.25 has been passed of escort party, amounting to transportation expenses in this case."

- Q.7 "Total of \$23.75 covered the cost of transportation of the accused and one other prisoner?"
- Q.8 Therefore, it is reasonable to suppose \$11.88 should be charged against the accused as the cost of his return to Calgary?". A.7 "Yes, sir". A.8 "Yes, sir".
