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Q.83            Wouldn't it be reasonable to ask for a small advance?  
A.83            I knew Captain Jessop was coming down that weekend sir.

Q.84            Yes, and what?  
A.84            So if I would have needed any money I could have asked  
in Gronigen.

Q.85            I see. But you didn't need any to go to Gronigen?  
A.85            No sir.

Q.86            No-one ever does.

J.A:            You are not giving evidence, Captain Wright.

Def Offr:       That was a question. I put an inflection --

President:      I'm afraid you are giving evidence.

Def Offr:       Pardon sir?

President:      I'm afraid you are giving evidence.

Def Offr:       I'm sorry sir.

President:      I wish you would be more careful.

Def Offr:       I'll try sir.

The Defending Officer continues with the cross-examination of the witness:

Q.87            Now-Corporal, on the question of the border crossing. Did  
you at any time have any trouble crossing the border?  
A.87            No sir.

Q.88            Whether you were going down by jeep or by any other kind  
of vehicle?  
A.88            No sir.

Q.89            You are quite familiar with the situation on the border  
are you not?  
A.89            Yes sir.

Q.90            What was the procedure at the border? What did they do  
there when they were checking vehicles?  
A.90            They ask you for a work ticket and they looked at the  
signature.

Q.91            Yes. And that's all that was necessary?  
A.92            That's right, sir.

Q.92            That's all thank you. Oh, just a minute - one question.  
You are in custody at the present time are you not?  
A.92            Yes sir.

Q.93            And you have not had communicated to you your sentence in  
any way, have you?  
A.93            No sir.

Q.94            And have you been told or has anyone suggested to you or  
do you think in your own mind that the outcome of this  
particular case may affect in some way the confirmation of  
any sentence that may be passed on you?  
A.94            I don't know, sir.

Q.95            Has anybody suggested that to you?  
A.95            No sir.

Q.96            They haven't?  
A.96            No sir.

Q.97            You were in court the other day when the Defence Counsel
