The accused persons will be warned and all witnesses duly required to attend.

The Commendant, No. 12 Military Detention Barracks, will arrange for the necessary accommodation, stationery and court orderly and will also ensure that the necessary escort has been provided.

The Commandant, The Royal Canadian Armoured Corps School, will arrange for the attendance of the necessary shorthand writer.

The Commanding Officer of each soldier brought before the Court for trial will, if the accused requires it, detail an interpreter for the trial of such soldier.

The proceedings will be forwarded to the AA & QMG, Central Command.
