These latter are the fuel stored up by the body and tormally burned up in the production of necessary bodily heat.

"When alcohol is consumed it furnishes heat—though not a flatural heat—and this expenditure is avoided. The fat is therefore stored up in the body unused, and couplence is the necessary result. This, of course in not a normal condition nor a proper process. It becomes more unnatural with increasing use of alcohol."
