The Adjoining Municipality Want City Compelled to Give Reasonable Rates

(From Monday's Daily) Committees representing the municipalities of South Saanich, Oak Bay and Esquimalt have recently met to discuss the question of having a separate water supply, independent of the city.

At the regular meeting of the Saanich municipal council, held on Monday last, the report of the waterworks committee was read and discussed.

A resolution was also passed providing for the provincial government to be asked to grant a loan of \$100,000 to the municipalities of Saanich and Oak Bay.

The charter to be granted to the municipalities of Saanich and Oak Bay shall supply all parties of the city limits to a reasonable amount with water at a fixed rate.
