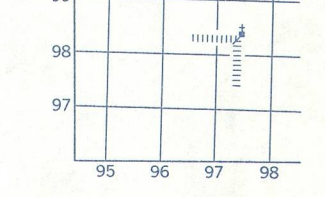

REFERENCE POINT CHURCH (see above)

EASTING: Read number on grid line
immediately to left of point
Estimate tenths of a square from
this line nearest to point

NORTHING: Read number on grid line
immediately below point
Estimate tenths of a square from
this line nearest to point

EXAMPLE: MILITARY GRID REFERENCE 979504
Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 62 miles)

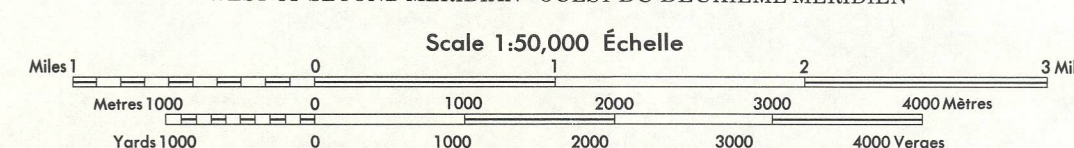
