Hon. Mr. Baxter Moves, Seconded by Mr. Magee, that Government Take Action Looking Towards Maritime Legislative Union.

The Provincial House will be called upon to express an opinion on the de-sirability of maritime legislative union. The following important resolution, moved by Hon. J. B. M. Baxter, and conded by Fred Magee, a govern-ent supporter, will be moved in the buse on Thursday next:

For Thursday next. Moved—Mr. Baxter. Seconded—Mr. Magee,
Whereas, the growth and development of the western provinces of Canada have been much greater in the past than that of the Maritime Provinces and are likely to be still greater after the war;

And whereas, the representation of the Maritime Provinces in the Dominion Parliament is not likely to increase and possibly may be deed assed if the population of such provinces shall not increase proportionately to that of Canada as a whole;

And whereas, it is becoming more and more imortant that there shall be unity of aim and action among the representatives of the Maritime in the Dominion Parliament so that the said provinces may obtain from the development of Canada such advantages in commerce and transportation as will give them a fair share in the benefits accruing from the development of our country.

And whereas, the assembling together of representative men of the Maritime Provinces in the transaction of public business would tend to promote community of aim, unity of action and a wider understanding of the needs of these communities:

Therefore resolved, That this house would favorably regard any action which the government may be disposed to take for the purpose of ascertaining whether the Provinces of Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island or either of them would be willing to consider the question of legislative union of the Maritime Provinces.

Charles H. McDonald, whose residence was badly damaged by a blast on Saturday last, went to Fredericton Thursday night. and stated yesterday that in future every precaution would be taken to see that damage would not result.

He expressed himself as satisfied that there would not be a repetition of the damage caused to his residence. The contractors say that in future blasts will only occur once every few weeks, and greater precautions will be taken than before.
