**NO FURTHER NEED OF ALARM**

The residents of Woodman's Point  
now feel assured that in the future  
there will be no fear of danger from  
flying rocks when a heavy blast is  
fired on the Valley Railway works at  
that place. Another big blast was  
fired on Thursday morning. There were  
no rocks flying and no damage to prop-  
erty.

Charles H. McDonald, whose resi-  
dence was badly damaged by a blast  
on Saturday last, went to Fredericton  
Thursday night, and stated yesterday  
that in future every precaution would  
be taken to see that damage would  
not result.

He expressed himself as satisfied  
that there would not be a repetition of  
the damage caused to his residence.

blasts will only occur once every few  
weeks, and greater precautions will be  
taken than before.
