Where an individual, department or institution is aggrieved by a report or recommendation of the Commissioner, or by a decision made by him or other person or authority acting upon his report or recommendation, the individual, department or institution may appeal in respect of such report, or recommendation or decision on a finding of fact, a question of law or a matter of the merits to a superior court of record within thirty days after the individual, department or institution is first informed of the report, or recommendation or decision; the court may proceed by way of hearing or review and shall make such order therein as the court deems just and such order shall be final."
