Some Handy Hints.

To make jellies and blancmanges set quickly, place the moulds containing them in a bowl of water in which two teaspoonfuls each of salt and common washing soda have been dissolved.

To keep the hands cool when making pastry, wash them in water as hot as is bearable, and then rise in a strong solution of brine.

Sandwiches may be freshened by wrapping them in a clean cloth, sprinkled with hot water, and keeping them in a cool cellar till wanted.
