A shipowner. Sat for present seat from g.e., 1861, until g.e., 1867. Again returned at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Kentville.*

MORRISON, THOMAS FLETCHER. [*Colchester.*]

Family, originally from Scot., removed to Irel. many years ago. Great grandf. emigrated to Am. Colonies. S. of the late Mr. Joseph Morrison, a native of Londonderry, N.S., by Isabella Fletcher; and grands. of Mr. Morrison, who removed to N.S. from New Hampshire, 1760, and sat in the N.S. Parlt. for many years. B. at Londonderry, N.S., 22 Feb., 1808. Ed. there. 1st, 1838, Miss Hannah Faulkner (who d. 1842); 2ndly, 1844, Miss Margaret B. Fletcher. Was a master mariner for many years. Is migrant Agent for N.S., and Surveyor of Shipping in Londonderry. Introduced and carried through the N.S. Legislature the act establishing vote by ballot at elections. Sat for North Colchester from 1855 to 1863. First returned for Colchester at g.e., 1867. Re-elected by acclamation at last g.e. A Liberal.—*Londonderry.*
