An Act respecting the Temiscouata Railway Company.

WHEREAS the Temiscouata Railway Company has, by its Preamble. Preamble petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and 5 consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

- 1. Section 2 of chapter 63 of the statutes of 1897, is hereby 1897, c. 63, repealed.
- 2. The extensions authorized by section 2 of chapter 65 of Time for the statutes of 1895, and section 3 of chapter 63 of the statutes of railway of 1897, shall be commenced within three years, and completed extended within five years after the passing of this Act, otherwise the powers granted for such construction shall cease and be null and void as respects so much of the extensions as then remains 15 uncompleted.
