

their Annual Meetings or Special Meeting, called for the purpose, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make such bye-laws and regulations respecting the running at large of all animals on the commons and highways, within the limits of any such Parish or Township, as they may judge expedient; and also all such bye-laws and regulations as they may deem expedient for the preservation of good order, and for the better management of their local affairs; Provided always that such bye-laws and regulations are not contrary to any law in force in this Province.

XXI. And it is hereby further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the amount of costs to be recovered on any prosecution before a Magistrate or Magistrates, may be regulated and directed by the householders and proprietors at their Parish or Township Meeting, and if the householders and proprietors shall fail to regulate the amount of such costs, they shall in no instance exceed the sum of

XXII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that if any person, at any meeting held for the purposes of, and authorized by this Act, shall vote more than once on the same question, or for the same purpose, or shall vote, and not being a householder and proprietor, and shall be thereof convicted before the nearest Magistrate, upon the testimony of two credible witnesses, he shall pay, for the benefit of the Parish or Township, in which such offence shall have been committed, a fine of to be recovered by the Clerk, Treasurer or Parish or Township Wardens.

XXIII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that this Act shall continue and be in force until the first day of May, 18 and no longer.
