## An Act to incorporate The Horticultural Society, of Montreal.

THEREAS the establishment of a So- Preamble. ciety, in the City of Montreal, for the encouragement and advancement of Horticulture and the Arts and Sciences therewith 5 connected, would greatly promote that branch of science: And whereas the persons hereinafter mentioned have associated themselves for the purpose of forming such a Society, under the name of The Canadian Horticul-10 tural Society, and have represented that they cannot effectually carry out the object they have in view without an Act of incorporation vesting in them such powers as may be

necessary for the purposes aforesaid, and 15 have prayed that such Act be passed, and it is right and expedient to grant their prayer : Be it therefore enacted, &c.
