C A P. XXXIX.

An Act to allow the Importation of Rum, or other Spirits, from His Majesty's Colonies or Plantations in the *West Indies*, into the Province of *Quebec*, without Payment of Duty, under certain Conditions and Restrictions.



WHEREAS, by an Act made and Preamble.
 passed in the Fourteenth Year of
 the Reign of His present Majesty,
 a Duty of Sixpence is imposed
 on every Gallon of Rum, or other
 Spirits, which shall be imported
 or brought into any Part of the
 Province of *Quebec*, from any of His Majesty's Sugar
 Colonies in the *West Indies*: And whereas it would
 greatly tend to encourage a proper commercial Intercourse
 between the said Province and the said Colonies, if Rum,
 imported into the said Province in any Ship or Vessel
 which shall carry from thence, and land in any of His
 Majesty's
