

Mississauga By-laws

10,473 — To authorize execution of an agreement. (Contract TR 1-1973 — awarded to Disher-Farrand Ltd. for construction of pedestrian bridge in Elm-creek Park. General Committee Report Nov. 1, 72, adopted by council Nov. 13-72.)

10,474 — To authorize execution of an agreement. (This agreement is a requirement of the committee of adjustment re application for variance with respect to an extension to rear of an existing building. The applicant agrees to waive her rights to any claim of compensation or damages incurred by reason of any works performed on adjoining lands and flooding thereon in any future expropriation of lands required in this area by Metropolitan Toronto & Region Conservation Authority or the Town of Mississauga. Municipal address 2168 Dundas Street East.)

10,475 — To authorize the execution of an agreement between the County of Peel and the Town of Mississauga. (This agreement provides for a Grant-in Aid in the amount of \$75,000.00 to the Town for its portion of the cost of construction of the Burnhamthorpe Road Bridge at the Etobicoke Creek.)

10,476 — To accept a Deed of Land and execute a grant of easement. (Sewer easement and future road widening conveyed to the town by Kaneff Construction Ltd. Pt. Lot 33, Con. 1, S.D.S. and Pt. Block B, Plan 467. Land severance)

10,477 — To authorize execution of a grant of easement. (Easement for sewer purposes in Block B, R.P. 467 — granted to the town by Robert H. Watson. Condition for land severance.)

10,478 — To accept a deed of land. (Road widening for Creditview Road. Gratuitous conveyance from A.G. Clarkson as a condition to a land severance.)

10,479 — To execute an acknowledgment. (This is required to clear title of buy-back option by the town with respect to an industrial lot in Rifle Range Industrial subdivision owned by Wm. E. Small. A building was constructed within the time required by the option contained in the deed.)

10,480 — To execute a grant of easement. (This is a watermain easement in Pt. Lot 12, Con. 2 N.D.S. (Burnhamthorpe Road East) conveyed to the town gratuitously by Golden-B Construction Co. Ltd.)

10,481 — To establish certain lands as part of a municipal highway. (Lands to be known as Bath Road, Rena Road and Slough Street — located west of Airport Road and north of Derry Road. This by-law opens road allowances in the Slough Estates Subdivision as part of the public highway system.)

10,482 — To accept a deed of land and a grant of easement. (Conditions of engineering agreement for McLaughlin Industrial Subdivision, R.P. 963 located south of Burnhamthorpe Road and west of Wolfedale Rd.)

10,483 — To remove certain lands from part-lot control. (To remove S.B. McLaughlin Industrial plan 963 from subdivision control; also Blocks A to X, R.P. 964, Bob-Claire)

10,484 — To authorize the execution of an agreement between Focal Properties Ltd. and the Town of Mississauga. (This agreement provides for the payment of \$750. per acre

drainage levy for all of the blocks on R.P. 963. The agreement will be registered on title in order to protect prospective purchasers.)

10,485 — To authorize the pulling down of unsafe buildings. (Approved by council on Feb. 12, 1973. Municipal address is 1076 East Ave. The owner has been notified by registered mail that this by-law will be considered at this meeting.)

10,303 — To authorize construction of sanitary sewers and private drain connections in Mississauga at an estimated total cost of \$30,000. (On Dundas Street East from 300 feet east of Wharton Way to 1,000 feet east of Wharton Way. This project has received OMB approval.)

10,486 — To authorize the temporary borrowing of \$30,000 pending the issue and sale of debentures. (To provide for temporary financing for sanitary sewer project in by-law 10,303.)

10,302 — To authorize construction of sanitary sewers

and private drain connections in the town at an estimated total cost of \$40,000. (On Dixie Road from Aimco Blvd. southerly a distance of 1,000 feet. This project has received OMB approval.)

10,487 — To authorize the temporary borrowing of \$40,000 pending the issue and sale of debentures. (This will provide for temporary financing for sanitary sewer project in By-law 10,302.)

10,338 — To authorize the construction of a watermain in the Town of Mississauga Water Area at an estimated total cost of \$79,600 (of which \$16,312 is to be debentured). (Watermain on Winston Churchill Blvd. and easements from Dundas St. West to the Collegeway. This project has received O.M.B. approval)

10,488 — To authorize the temporary borrowing of \$79,600 (of which \$16,312 is to be debentured) pending the issue and sale of debentures. (This will provide for temporary financing for watermain construction project in By-law 10,338.)

10,489 — To authorize execution of a housekeeping agreement between Jomona Construction Ltd. and the Town of Mississauga. (File OZ-19-71. Pt. Lot 1, R.P. G-14 and part Lot 10, Con. 1, S.D.S.)

10,490 — To amend By-law 5500 as amended. (File OZ-19-71 — Jomona Construction Ltd. To change zoning from M1 to M1-Section 327 to permit a retail sales outlet and warehouse, subject to site plan approval, etc. The engineering dept. recommends passing of this by-law with processing to be withheld until deed for 1 ft. reserves has been received by the town. All other town requirements have been met.)

10,491 — To amend Traffic By-law No. 7037 (To add "NO STOPPING" on Thorn Lodge Drive, Tedwyn Drive and Silver Creek Boulevard, both sides in certain areas between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday to Friday inclusive. As recommended in General Committee Report March 7, Item 250. In School zones.)

10,492 — To amend By-law 8744. (To provide for maximum speed of 25 miles per hour in school zones on Mississauga Valley Boulevard. As recommended in General Committee Report March 7, Item 251.)

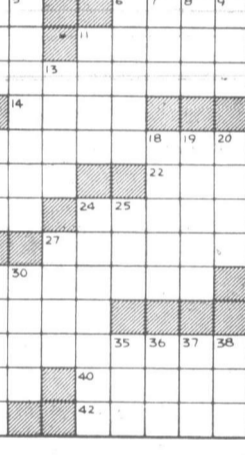
10,494 — To establish certain lands as part of a municipal highway. (This by-law lifts the one foot reserve at the easterly end of Selsey Drive, Plan 763 and allows access into R.P. 881 located north of the North Service Road, running easterly from Munden Road.)

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When you complain about improper advertising, we do something about it. Fast. For example:

The case of the Magic Mouse

From the files of the Advertising Standards Council

One day a consumer sent us a "Magic Mouse" toy. She complained that the television advertising had exaggerated the quality and performance of the product. And after examining the product and the advertising, we agreed.

This is the advertising rule that was broken:

"No advertisement shall be prepared, or be knowingly accepted, which contains false, misleading, unwarranted or exaggerated claims — either directly or by implication. Advertisers and advertising agencies must be prepared to substantiate their claims."

Here's what we did about it, immediately.

First we phoned the television station that had run the "Magic Mouse" commercial. They told us they had already cancelled the commercial because of similar complaints. Since the advertiser (a U.S. company) did not reply to our inquiry, we issued an "urgent" bulletin requesting all stations to contact us before accepting advertising from this company. The "Magic Mouse" is no longer advertised.

Keep this complaint notice. If you see dishonest or unfair advertising, send it to us.
