Thus the average present and future taxation of the Canadian people for current purposes has been reduced from \$52.43 per head in 1921 and \$44.87 in 1922 to \$31.38 in 1925 and \$31.86 in 1926, the slight increase in the latest year being due largely to the increased payments in war pensions and to the compensation paid to the Home Bank depositors. Of that \$31.86 of current taxation, \$17.10 was due to the war.
