With further reference to my letter to you of the 20<sup>th</sup> Ultimo relative to your telegram that Madam Farjana was making cordwood on the Fort William Reserve and that the Indians do not think she has any right to do so, - I beg to inform you that the following telegram was received from Madam Farjana on the 23<sup>rd</sup> Ultimo:-

I am only cutting timber nine inches at stumps. About two thirds limit burnt - only way it can be utilized is in cordwood.
