

road complained of is the best road on the Reserve, and that they thought it would be wrong to alter it; that the alterations could not be made without considerable difficulty, and that were the road to be placed where Fisher wishes it to be, it would do little good to any party, and would put the middle of the road in the ditch.

There is a difference of opinion among the Indians in regard to the question, and it is surmised that those who are endeavoring to have a change made in the line of road have some other object in doing so than the good of the community.
