Tour letter of the 14th of Jume was received by Mr. Awrey at English River and in reply to the same I new wish to inferm you that in view of the contradictory information given I am unable to substantiate your claim to be paid Treaty 9 Annuity.

Tou state that you were born
May 1st, 1900, but the records here show
that your father, William Scott, was paid
for the first time under his ewn number,
No. 268, Albany Band, in 1915, he having
been paid under No. 91, Albany Band, with
his father, Joseph H. Scott, Your father
was married to the daughter of John V.
Kataquapit, No. 42, Albany Band. You,
therefore, can see that there must be
wrong information given and unless you can
produce satisfactory proof of your claim,
no further action can be taken by the
Bepartment.
