

Ottawa, August 3rd, 1933.

Dear Madam:-

Your letter of the 14th of June was received by Mr. Awrey at English River and in reply to the same I now wish to inform you that in view of the contradictory information given I am unable to substantiate your claim to be paid Treaty 9 Annuity.

You state that you were born May 1st, 1900, but the records here show that your father, William Scott, was paid for the first time under his own number, No. 268, Albany Band, in 1915, he having been paid under No. 91, Albany Band, with his father, Joseph H. Scott. Your father was married to the daughter of John W. Kataquapit, No. 42, Albany Band. You, therefore, can see that there must be wrong information given and unless you can produce satisfactory proof of your claim, no further action can be taken by the Department.
