I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 3rd inst. inclosing a complaint of the Chief and one Councillor of the Restigouche Reserve against Thomas Isaac, Constable, and asking for the appointment of Lemax Sewell in his stead, I have to say that a communication has also been received from Thomas Isaac in which he denies the statement that he neglects his duty as constable.

Before dealing with this matter the Department desires to have from you a more definite report as to whether you consider anything would be gained by dispensing with the services of Isaac and the appointment of Sewell in his place.
