
I have to refer to communication addressed you on June 18th last requesting payment of the third instalment of purchase money on the E.1/2, Sec. 6, Tp. 20, Rge. 23, W-4-M, and as the same was not complied with, I am again calling attention to your indebtedness.

There is payable the sum of \$847.25, composed of \$731.73 principal and \$115.52 interest, which is computed to the 14th instant.

As the Department is unable to complete the obligations incurred with the Indians when surrender was taken without the purchasers forwarding the due instalments, it is expected that you will forward the above total, without fail, on receipt of this letter.

Failure to comply with this request, will be met by considering cancellation of the sales, forfeiture of moneys paid and redispotion of the land.
