I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 24th ultimo, in regard to purchase by the School Board of lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12, in Block 20, of The Pas and desiring an extension of time for making the first payment.

In reply I would say that the Department is prepared to accept one-fifth of the purchase price, in cash, the balance in four equal, annual instalments with interest at five per cent. and if the School Board is desirous of further time to pay the future instalments, there would be no objection to granting a reasonable extension.
