- d) the prevention of discrimination on grounds of race, sex, language or religion;
- e) any other matter concerning human rights not covered by items (a), (b), (c) and(d)".

Mr. Diefenbaker's resolution (No. 12 on the Order Paper) is of a more restricted and specific character. Mr. Stewart's resolution (No. 20) is somewhat more general. (Both texts attached).
