

- Q How did you detail personnel for that duty?
- A I got a list of the personnel for the parade from the R.S.M. I phoned some Departments, I got in touch personally with the rest of the men who were in the Canteen or around the Hospital.
- Q According to Orders, it was a coincidence that you happened to be the Orderly Sergeant as well as the Orderly N.C.O. on the 17th day of May, 1945?
- A That is right, Sir.
- Q So you were carrying out a dual job? I mean, you were a little busier than usual because you had to do two jobs?
- A That is right, Sir.
- Q Now, ^{how} did you advise Private Advent, if you advised him at all, that he was to be on parade during the afternoon of the 17th May?
- A Through Private Hayhurst. He works at the Officers' Mess. I warned him for parade the following day. I also told him to warn Private Advent to be on parade at the same time.
- Q What was Private Hayhurst doing at the time you warned him for this parade?
- A Having a cup of coffee, Sir.
- Q Was it during Canteen hours?
- A Yes, Sir; between three and three-fifteen, Sir.
- Q It was during a break?
- A Yes, Sir.
- Q Will you tell the Court exactly the instructions you gave Private Hayhurst concerning Private Advent?
- A The best way I put it, Sir, I told Private Hayhurst to be on parade the following day at 1315 hours and also to tell Private Advent to be on parade at the same time, Sir.
- Q Did you tell him what for?
- A I couldn't really answer that truthfully what it was for. I just said he had to be on parade at 1315 hours outside the Q.M. Stores.
- Q And you say you didn't state the reason for the parade?
- A Just a parade outside the Q.M. Stores, Sir.
- Q Would it, ^{be} usual, Sergeant Flynn, that when we have these parades they are for the purpose of training?
- A Yes, Sir.
- Q Were you under the assumption that this particular parade was also one for training?
- A No, Sir; I knew the parade was for a clean-up parade around the Hospital.
- Q But you told no one else about that? That is, you did not tell Private Hayhurst?
- A I can't remember, Sir.
