JA: Any questions by the Court, Mr. President?

QUESTIONED BY THE PRESIDENT

Q. Was Capt Simard there when you came in?

QUESTIONED BY JA

Q. Pte St. Pierre, is the Pte Brisson to whom you have referred in your evidence present in this Court-room?

A. Yes sir.

Q. Would you be good enough to point him out please?

A. That is him (indicates accused).

Q. How far was it from your Regimental Police Guard Room to the house where you found the accused?

A. Approximately 5 or 6 kilometres.

Q. Did you notice the number of the truck that was parked across the road near this house you were talking about?

A. No sir.

Q. How far was the Sten Gun, Exhibit "L", from the door through which you entered the house?

A. 15 to 20 yards.

Q. Was the Sten Gun, Exhibit "L", lying in the open or was it hidden?

A. It was simply thrown on the ground.

Q. It wasn't covered up in any way was it?

A. No sir.

Q. In your evidence you stated that a certain vehicle was Pte Brisson's. How do you know that?

A. I had seen it at the car park and he was driving that truck.

Q. In what manner did the accused walk when you took him out of the house?

A. He was somewhat staggersy - zig-zag.

Q. Zig-zag?

A. Yes.
