First Witness  
for Prosecution.

K-17104, Sgt. Battelley, J. H., "Admin Wing", No. 3 C.A.R.U., having been duly sworn, states:-

"I am Sgt. Battelley, J. H., Orderly Sergeant of Admin Wing. At approximately 0700 hrs on the 18 Mar 42 Gnr. Roman, F. was absent from his fatigue. I tried to locate him and having failed to do so I reported him absent to the Guard Room."

The accused declined to cross-examine this witness.

C-565, L/Bdr. Scanes, N. K., "Admin Wing", No. 3 C.A.R.U., having been duly sworn, states:-

"I am L/Bdr. Scanes, and as Orderly Bombardier of Admin Wing I called the roll in Hut No. 1 at approximately 2230 hrs on the 18 Mar 42, and Gnr. Roman, F. was absent. At Tattoo Parade I reported him absent."

The accused declined to cross-examine this witness.
