Replying to your letter of July 26th last
file No. 33-6-5746, in connection with resurvey
of Comox Indian Reserve No. 1, I beg to advise I
communicated with Mr. V. Schjelderup, Courtenay,
and I enclose you, herewith, copy of his letter
which is self-explanatory.

In this connection I would strongly
recommend that ~~an~~ approval be given to this resurvey
as there is grave doubts in the minds of the Indians,
myself and Mr. Schjelderup as to the present line
fence between the Reserve and adjacent property. I
feel confident that if a resurvey is made, discrepancies
will be found, and recommend this should be undertaken
at an early date, preferably during the present winter
when the Indians are home and able to supply the
surveyor with any information they may have.
