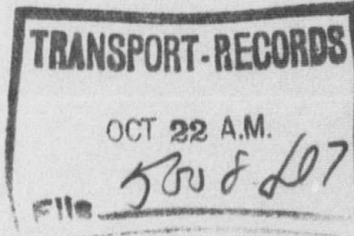

This is to advise you that at approxamety 1330 hrs. Oct. 17 while in charge as pilot of aireraft CF-DGZ, I encountered a sudden and severe snow storm over Percupine Lake on the appreach for landing.

The aircraft came in contact with the water hard, breaking the the floats from the machine and the aireraft sank to the bottom of the lake within twenty minutes

No injuries were sustained by the passenger or pilot.

This aircraft is now considered a total lossthis machine was owned and operated by the Percupine Airways. Please advise.
