The steamer "Otonabee" is a staunchly built craft, having a licensed carrying capacity of 450 people and is fitted with twin screws, is electric lighted and is thoroughly equipped with everything requisite to make an up-to-date passenger service boat. The mind cannot picture anything more exquisitely beautiful than to take the evening trip from Barrie to Peninsular Park, listening to the strains of the orchestra on board, the steamer's searchlight playing on the shore, and treating the eye to the ever varying shades of foliage as one glides along for nine miles over the shimmering waters of Kempenfeldt Bay.
