

request of five members in good standing, or by the vote of the Lodge, and in either case the members must be notified by the Secretary. At such special meetings no business other than that for which the meeting was summoned may be transacted.

Art. 4. Quarterly meetings and returns, see Section I, Constitution.

Art. 5. Intoxicating liquors shall not be allowed in the Lodge room, nor shall members retire to partake of said liquors and re-enter the room the same night. Smoking shall be strictly prohibited in the Lodge room at all times.

Art. 6. No member shall retire without leave of the N. G., and during the opening, closing, or taking the ayes or nays, the doors shall be kept closed.

SECTION III.

MEMBERSHIP.

Art. 1. Every person initiated into this Lodge shall be qualified as provided for in Section II, Art. 16, Constitution.
