The gathering of Young Baptists of America, held in the Massey Music Hall, on the dates given above, surpassed anything of its kind ever held in the City of Toronto; and so far as Baptists are concerned, on the continent of America.

From East and West, from North and South they came, until nearly every State in the Union and every Province in the Dominion was represented by delegate or visitor. The report of the enrollment Committee, given on Saturday morning, showed the following: "By divisions, the numbers present are: Foreign, 6; Northern States west of the Mississippi River, 178; Southern States, 337; Northern States east of the Mississippi, 2,497; from all parts of Canada, 2,521; grand total, 5,539." To this must be added 175 enrolled after the report given above, making in all 5,714. This does not include all who were present, as many failed to register. Young Baptists are making history, and these annual gatherings are the way-marks by which to judge of the progress, permanency and efficiency of the movement inaugurated in Chicago in 1891.
