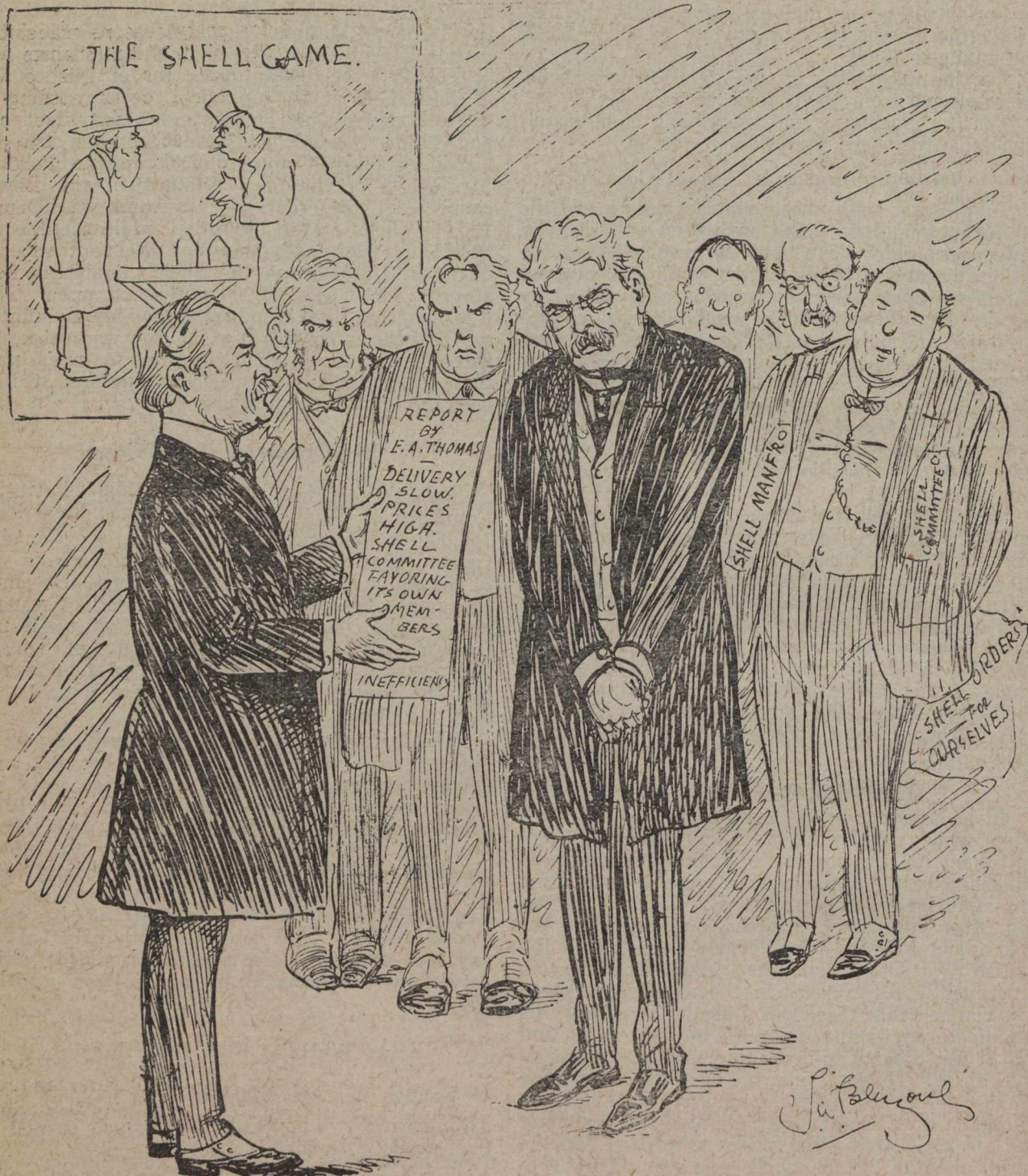


TRIED AND FOUND WANTING
