The faid refolution was again read, and the queftion being put there. on, the House divided :

So it was carried in the affirmative, and

RESOLVED, that this House doth concur with the Committee in the faid resolution.

Mr. Papineau, junior, moved, seconded by Mr. Durocher :

That the faid Bill be engroffed.
