III.-The monies hereinbefore granted shall be paid by the Receiver Monies to be paid by Varrant drawn by General in discharge of such Warrants as may from time to time be drawn the Governor. by the Governor for the purposes of this Act; and it shall not be lawful for the Receiver General to pay any monies out of the Colonial Treasury other than such as are granted by this Act, or some other Act of the Legislature : Provided that any sums of money advanced by the Government of this Colony, on account of any of the foregoing appropriations, shall be deducted therefrom.
