TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING.

**W**HEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands prorogued until FRIDAY the TWELFTH day of DECEMBER, instant: and whereas I think fit to Prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY until WEDNESDAY the TWENTY-EIGHTH day of JANUARY next ensuing: I do, therefore, by this my Proclamation, further prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY, until WEDNESDAY the TWENTY-EIGHTH day of JANUARY next, *then to meet for the despatch of business*: of which all Persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my hand and Seal at the  
Government House at St. John's, in  
the said Island, the Ninth day of De-  
cember, A. D. One Thousand Eight  
Hundred and Sixty-two, and in the  
Twenty-sixth Year of Her Majes-  
ty's Reign.
