An Ordinance in aid of the Trustees' Relief Act.

[31st January, 1866.]

WHEREAS an Act of the Imperial Parliament was passed in the Reciter Imperial Act
Session of Parliament, holden in the 10th and 11th years of 10 \$ 11 Vic., c. 16.
the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter 96, intituled "An Act for better securing Trust Funds, and for the relief of Trustees."

AND, WHEREAS, it is expedient more fully to enact the same;

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of British Columbia, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

I. The "Trustees' Relief Ordinance, 1865," is hereby repealed.

Repeal of Trustees' Relief Ordinance, 1865.

II. The said first above recited Act of the 10th and 11th years of Trustees' Relief Act the Reign of Her Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter 96, hereinafter to have force from called "The said Trustees' Relief Act," shall be and have the force 19th Nov., 1858. of law, and shall be deemed to have been so in force within the Colony of British Columbia and its Dependencies, since the 19th day of November, A. D. 1858.
