Synopsis of Canadian North-West Land Regulations.

THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 y are old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manntoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or sub-Agency for the district. Entry hy proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (out not Sub-Agency,) on certain conditions.

Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live with a nine miles of his homestead on a farm o at least 80 acres, on certain conditions A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity. In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may ore-empt a quarter section alongside his h mestead. Price \$3.00 per acre.

Duties—Six months residence in each of three years after warning bomestead patent; also 50 acres extra cultivation Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead petcui; on certain conditions.

Asettler who has exhausted his home-stead right may take a purchased home-stead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 pc. acre. Duties—Must reside six month outof three years, cultivate \$0 acres and erect a house worth \$300.

The art of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scrubby or tony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions.
